When we hosted the last tournament in the Summer Term we had to use temporary poles as goalposts. We also have re-introduced mixed and girls only football training sessions and purchasing 2 sets would be greatly beneficial.

A significant amount of our Primary Sports Budget over the years has been used to provide further training in PE for our HLTA. This enables her to take PE across the school and work closely with the HT who is also the PE co-ordinator.  Using Primary sports budget enables this to continue and build upon the achievements of the last years. One area that needs further CPD is dance so the HLTA will work alongside the company for both days and then access any further training afterwards.
