Activities Week for remaining KS2 children

Monday 22nd May – Wednesday 24th May 2023.

Dear Parents/Carers,

The majority of Class 3 and a good number of children in Class 2 will be away on a residential for 3 days next week. I will be the teacher in charge of the children, supported by Mrs Chisholm and Mrs Morris. As such, I have organised a different few days and the details are as follows:

Monday 21st May – Outdoor Learning Day (School Grounds)

Please can the children come into school dressed in old, comfortable clothes, suitable for outdoor learning (waterproofs etc). The school day will run as usual apart from this and there are no additional costs.

Tuesday 22nd May – Delights of Alnwick

The children will travel by bus and visit Alnwick Gardens in the morning, have a packed lunch (Please provide this. However, if your child has free school meals and you would like a packed lunch provided by school, please let the office know today). We will then take a leisurely walk (if there is time we may call into Barter Books) to Willowburn where we will **ALL** be in the swimming pool and taking part in water safety activities as it is National Water Safety Week. The bus will pick us up as usual and we will have our PE session upon returning to school.

The children will need: reading book (to be used before our trip and to be kept at school), packed lunch, swimming things, water bottle, jacket, cap, sun cream etc that is in a bag which can be carried independently and to wear their school PE kit **as well as have additional shorts and t shirt or pyjamas to use in the swimming pool on top of their swimming things.**

School has a class 'card' for Alnwick Gardens and transport costs are covered with our weekly swimming lessons charges so there is no additional cost for this.

Wednesday 23rd May - The Ingram Valley Farm Safari

The children will travel by bus to Ingram Bridge carpark where we will be greeted by the team from Ingram Valley Farm Safari and we will go on our own mini adventure!

We will return to school in time for lunch and activities in school so please can the children also bring their reading folder, water bottle etc?

The Wilson family (Tilly and Luca's parents) have kindly offered this experience for no charge! Therefore, the only contribution is towards the cost of transport which is £3.63.
