Goals for 2 year olds



By the time children leave their 2 year old provision, the vast majority will be able to:



Communication and Language Goals

Say 'please help' and 'more please' when help is needed with self-care skills

Join in with group songs, rhymes and routines

Listen to a story in a small group

Follow simple instructions containing 2 to 3 key words

Physical Goals

Put coat on independently and find and try to put on own shoes

Pull up own sleeves and wash hands

Try to use a knife and fork

Move in a range of ways and walk unaided for increase periods of time

Goals for 2 year olds



By the time children leave their 2 year old provision, the vast majority will be able to:



PSED Goals

Take turns with an adult

Be aware of and express some key feelings, e.g. happy, sad, hungry, tired, angry, excited

Play alongside other children cooperatively

Wear pants during the day

Literacy Goals

Explore and make meaningful marks in different contexts

Syllable clap with support/in a group

Know a core set of nursery rhymes

Goals for 2 year olds



By the time children leave their 2 year old provision, the vast majority will be able to:



Maths Goals

Identify simple shapes, i.e., circle, square, triangle, star Understand simple concepts, including big and small, long and short, heavy and light

Count 1:1 correspondence to 3



Goals for preschoolers

By the time children leave their 3&4 year old provision, the vast majority will be able to:



Communication and Language Goals

Listen to and respond to simple questions

Talk about themselves, their likes and interests

Use age appropriate grammar, e.g., "I" when talking about self as the subject

Turn take in conversations with adults and children

Physical Goals

Attempt to fasten own zip on coat

Take off own jumper

Hold scissors correctly and cut at least a straight line

Hold a pencil using a static tripod grip

Goals for preschoolers

By the time children leave their 3&4 year old provision, the vast majority will be able to:



PSED Goals

Independently go to the toilet and tell and adult if they've had an accident

To have an awareness of their own feelings and the feelings of others

Turn take mostly independently

Literacy Goals

Write own name with some recognisable letters

Recall core nursery rhymes without adult help

Know and join in with repeated refrains from core texts

Goals for preschoolers

By the time children leave their 3&4 year old provision, the vast majority will be able to:



Maths Goals

Count with 1:1 correspondence to 5

Recognise numbers that are important to them

Understand positional language, "around, over, under, on, behind"
