New Childcare Reforms

You may already be aware, starting from April 2024, existing childcare support will be expanded for working families. This means that: From **April 2024**, working parents of 2-year-olds will be able to access up to 15 hours childcare support. Parents can apply for their funded childcare codes through the <u>Childcare Choices website</u> from 2nd January 2024.

Details of the code and confirmation of eligibility will need to be given to school before a place is confirmed.

We are pleased to offer some afternoon places for **Rising 3 Year Old** 1.00 - 3.15 for working parents or a fee paying place through our Community Powers Nursery f**rom 15th April 2024** using our school environment and specialist facilities for younger children.
